This award is sponsored by the Withers Family in the honor of the memory of Ted Withers Mr. Withers was a former Chairperson of the Newfoundland and Labrador Figure Skating Association and instrumental in starting the young judges training program. He was also President of the St. John's Figure Skating Club, Chairman of the Newfoundland & Labrador Sport Federation, an inducted member in the Newfoundland Sport Hall of Fame. and a great spokesperson for skating in this province and would not settle for second best in anything. His motto was – "No matter where you place or what you do, just enjoy your skate and give it all you got." It was easy to hear him shout "SELL" – meaning 'go for it'. The award is presented annually to any skater performing in the Newfoundland and Labrador Provincial Figure Skating Championships who has presented the MOST OUTSTANDING PERFORMANCE at the competition.
