There is an \$8.00 officials and technology development fee (ODF) per skater. Additional categories may be offered as an exhibition. Please contact scnljennifer@sportnl.ca. All categories are subject to the availability of qualified officials.

ONLINE REGISTRATION:

Registration for all categories will take place on the Skate Canada Newfoundland and Labrador Registration website: https://skatenf.uplifterinc.com.

Methods of payment include: VISA, MasterCard and Discover Card. PrePaid VISA/MasterCard gift cards are also accepted.

Registration Opens: Monday, November 25, 2019 at 12:00PM

Registration Deadline: Thursday, December 5, 2019

Late entries will NOT be accepted.

REFUND POLICY:

Refund requests must be made by **Thursday, December 5, 2019**. After this date, all refunds will require a medical note and are subject to a \$25 administration fee. Medical notes must be submitted within **14 days** of the Event.

AGE RESTRICTIONS:

Age is considered to be the age of the skater before July 1, preceding the Event.

ELIGIBILITY:

Skaters who participated in a qualifying category (PreNovice and higher) at the SCNL Sectional Championships, in the current year, are ineligible for a STARSkate category, in the same discipline, at Divisionals and Provincials.

TEST/ASSESSMENT QUALIFYING DEADLINE:

Test/Assessment requirements must be met at the time of online registration.

MUSIC:

Two copies of music are to be submitted on CD at registration. Each CD should be clearly marked with the following information:

- 1) Skater's name and home club
- 2) Category
- 3) Recording time of music
- 4) "Master" or "Copy"

COACHES ACCREDITATION:

Coaches must be a minimum of NCCP Regional Coach In-Training and be a current Professional Coaching Member of Skate Canada, in Good Standing.

SCHEDULE:

A detailed schedule will be posted on the SCNL website (https://skatenl.com), within 2 weeks of the Event.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION:

Will begin one hour prior to the start of the Event.

AWARDS:

The top three placements in each category (STAR 4 & higher) will be awarded a prize. In a category where there are less than three entries, the number of prizes will equal the number of entries.

MEDAL PRESENTATIONS: Medals presentations, for STAR 4 and higher events, will be scheduled and medal presentation times will be posted in the Arena. Skaters are asked to wear competition outfits and skates.

CERTIFICATE PRESENTATIONS: All skaters in STAR 1-3 will receive an evaluation certificate & report card, to be presented following the completion of the category, at an announced time.

PROVINCIALS QUALIFYING CATEGORIES:

- Girls/Women Labrador Divisionals (Top three placements)
- Girls/Women Eastern & Western Divisionals (Top eight placements)

In the event that any of the qualifying placements do not enter the Provincial Championships, the next placed skater in the category shall be considered eligible.

The following categories skated at the Labrador Divisional Event do NOT qualify for Provincials: STAR 1-3 Singles, STAR 2/3 Dance, STAR 5-Gold Artistic.

Skaters qualifying to go to the Skate Canada Newfoundland and Labrador Provincial Championships must register online, immediately following the completion of their Divisional Event, and no later than **Wednesday, January 22, 2020**.

Skaters who participate in a qualifying category at Divisionals are ineligible to enter a byed category, in the same discipline, at the Provincial Championships.

BYED CATEGORIES:

All STAR 8, 9, 10 and Gold FreeSkate; CompetitiveSkate; Special Olympics, ADULTSkate, Boys/Men, Pairs and Dance competitors shall receive a bye through the Divisional Championships. Registration for the SCNL Provincials Championships must be completed online (https://skatenf.uplifterinc.com) no later than January 22, 2020.

Byes may also be granted in single entry categories at Divisionals. SCNL will inform skaters if they are eligible for a bye not later than 7 days after the registration deadline. Skaters then have 7 days, from the date of notice, to accept a bye and withdraw without penalty. Additional byes may be granted in extenuating circumstances and must be made in writing with supporting documents to the Executive Committee of Skate Canada Newfoundland and Labrador.

The Skate Canada Newfoundland and Labrador Provincial Championships is a qualifying event for the Atlantic Canada Skating Championships.
