Methods of payment include VISA, MasterCard and Discover Card. Pre-Paid VISA/MasterCard gift cards are also accepted.

Registration Opens: Wednesday, September 15, 2021 at 10:00AM **Registration Deadline:** Thursday, September 23, 2021 <u>*Note: Late entries will NOT be accepted.</u>

REFUND POLICY: Refund requests must be made before **Thursday, September 23, 2021**. After this date, all refunds will require a medical note and are subject to a \$25 administration fee. Medical notes must be submitted within **14 days** of the Event.

AGE RESTRICTIONS:

Age is considered to be the age of the skater before July 1, preceding the event.

AWARDS:

The top three placements in each category shall be awarded a medal. In a category where there are less than three entries, then the number of medals shall equal the number of entries. Medals will not be provided for exhibition skates.

MUSIC:

All music must be submitted electronically with online registration. Music files must be .mp3 and labeled as "Skaters Name_Category". Skaters should also have a CD copy of music available at ice level, during the Event.

COACHES ACCREDITATION:

Coaches must be a minimum of NCCP Regional Coach In-Training and be a current Professional Coaching Member of Skate Canada, in Good Standing.

SCHEDULE:

A detailed schedule will be posted on the Skate Canada NL website (<u>Rebecca Pack Memorial Friendship</u> <u>Skate – Skate Canada – Newfoundland & Labrador (skatenl.com)</u>) as soon as possible after the deadline for registration.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION:

All skaters and spectators must sign-in at the registration table when arriving at the Event.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

More information on COVID-19 regulations will be communicated to participants following the deadline for registration.

MEDAL PRESENTATIONS:

Medal presentation times will be scheduled and posted in the arena. Skaters are asked to wear competition outfits and skates.
