Late entries will not be accepted

**REFUND POLICY:** Refund requests must be made before **Thursday, August 4, 2022**. After this date, all refunds will require a medical note and are subject to a \$25 administration fee. Medical notes must be submitted within **14 days** following the Event.

### RESULTS/AWARDS:

Medals shall be awarded to the top three placements in each category. In a category where there are less than three entries, then the number of medals awarded shall equal the number of entries.

### MEDAL/CERTIFICATE PRESENTATIONS:

Medal and Certificate presentation times will be scheduled and posted in the Arena. **Skaters are asked to wear competition outfits and skates.**



**MUSIC:**

All music must be submitted electronically with online registration. Music files must be .mp3 and labeled as "Skaters Name\_Category". Skaters should also have a CD copy of music available at ice level, during the Event.

**COACHES ACCREDITATION:**

Coaches must be a minimum of NCCP Regional Coach In-Training and be a current Professional Coaching Member of Skate Canada, in Good Standing.
