All categories are subject to the availability of officials. Additional categories may be offered as an exhibition. Please contact scnljennifer@sportnl.ca by Wednesday, January 25, 2023, to request.

There is an \$8.00 officials and technology development fee (ODF) per skater. Registration also includes a digital action photo. Photos will be available to download following the Event.

ONLINE REGISTRATION:

Registration for all categories will take place on the Skate NL Registration website:

<https://skatenf.uplifterinc.com>. Methods of payment include: VISA, MasterCard and Discover Card. PrePaid VISA/MasterCard gift cards are also accepted.

Registration Deadline: Wednesday, January 25, 2023

Late entries will NOT be accepted.

QUALIFYING CATEGORIES:

All skaters qualifying through Divisionals (STAR 4, 5, 6, and 7) must register online after the completion of their Divisional Event.

BYED CATEGORIES:

All STAR 8, 9, 10 and Gold FreeSkate, CompetitiveSkate, Special Olympics, ADULTSkate, and Boys/Men will receive an automatic bye to the Skate NL Provincial Championships. Online registration for byed categories will open Tuesday, January 10, 2023.

REFUND POLICY:

Refund requests must be made by Wednesday, January 25, 2023. After this date, all refunds will require a medical note and are subject to a \$25 administration fee. Medical notes must be submitted within 14 days following the Event.

AGE RESTRICTIONS:

Age is considered to be the age of the skater before July 1, preceding the Event. **NOTE:** There is no upper age limit for STARSkate categories.

**ELIGIBILITY:**

- Skaters who participated in a qualifying category (PreNovice and higher) at the Skate NL Sectional Championships, in the current year, are ineligible for a STARSkate category, in the same discipline, at the Provincial Championships.
- Skaters who participate in a qualifying category at Divisionals are ineligible to enter a byed category, in the same discipline, at the Provincial Championships.

ASSESSMENT QUALIFYING DEADLINE:

Assessment requirements must be met at the time of online registration.

MUSIC:

All music must be submitted electronically with online registration. ***Please ensure correct music files are uploaded.*** Music file changes and mislabeled music files will be charged a \$25 administrative fee.

Skaters/Coaches should have a **USB** copy of music available at ice level, during the Event. CD's, phones, or other personal devices will **NOT** be accepted.

MUSIC UPLOAD INFORMATION:

- Music must be submitted for **all** categories/segments (ie: short program, free program etc.).
- Music files **must** be MP3.
- Music uploads **must** be named in the following format: **First Name Last Name - Category Program Type**
- First and Last Name **must** match the athlete's name as written on their Uplifter profile.

Category Program Type includes:

- **Category** (ie: STAR 5)
- **Discipline** (ie: Women/Girls, Men/Boys)
- **Segment** (ie: Short Program or Free Program, if applicable)
- **Age category** (ie: U10, if applicable)

Examples:

John Smith - STAR 5 Men 13&Over

Suzie Smith - PreNovice Women Short Program

COACHES ACCREDITATION:

Coaches must be a minimum of NCCP Regional Coach In-Training and be a current Professional Coaching Member of Skate Canada, in Good Standing.

SCHEDULE:

A detailed schedule will be posted on the Skate NL website ([SCNL Provincial Skating Championships – Skate Canada – Newfoundland & Labrador \(skatenl.com\)](http://skatenl.com)) as soon as possible after the registration deadline.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION:

Will begin one hour prior to the start of each category.

MEDALS:

Medals shall be awarded to the top three placements in each category. In a category where there are less than three entries, the number of medals awarded shall equal the number of entries.



MEDAL PRESENTATIONS:

Medals presentations will be scheduled and posted in the Arena. Skaters are asked to wear competition outfits and skates.

QUALIFYING CATEGORIES:

Provincials is a qualifying Event for the Atlantic Canada Skating Championships. The top 6 skaters in the following categories will be selected: STAR 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, Gold Singles, and PreJuvenile-Novice Singles. The Atlantic Canada Skating Championships will be held March 24-26, 2023 in Paradise, NL. More information will be distributed to qualifiers at the Provincial Championships.
