Skaters must register at least 1 hour before their event is scheduled to begin.

Coaches must register at least 1 hour before their first skater is scheduled to begin.

Coaches must be Regional Coach in training and must meet the following accreditation standards:

- be a current Professional Coaching Member of Skate Canada in good standing.
- It is mandatory for all participating coaches to register at the competition and always display their accreditation during the competition in order to be at ice level during the events.
- Temporary accreditation will be issued for \$25.00 upon presentation of current Skate Canada membership and First Aid information.

Further information related to accredited access to specific areas within the competition venue will be communicated on-site as necessary.

MUSIC INFORMATION

All skaters must have submitted music online as part of the registration process. Music used at the Event will be the electronic version submitted during registration.

 Competitors must have their back-up file on a USB flash drive, which must at the boards during competition. Alternate electronic items such as iPhones, tablets, mp3 players etc. will not be accepted for playing music.

RINKSIDE ACCESS

Only individuals with a coach accreditation, per the Coach Accreditation Policy, will be permitted to coach athletes.

Only two people will be allowed at the boards as determined by the skater/team (e.g., one Coach and one Section Rep. or two Coaches).

A third individual may be in the Skater On or Skater Off area (e.g., Section Rep.)

The Technical Representative has the authority to alter the rinkside access based on the venue.
