Methods of payment include VISA, MasterCard and Discover Card. PrePaid VISA/MasterCard gift cards are also accepted.

Registration Opens: Friday, September 29, 2023, at NOON

Registration Deadline: Thursday, October 5, 2023

Late entries will NOT be accepted.



REFUND POLICY: Refund requests must be made by **Thursday, October 5, 2023**. After this date, all refunds will require a medical note and are subject to a \$25 administration fee. Medical notes must be submitted within **14 days** following the Event.

MEDALS & MEDAL PRESENTATIONS (STAR 4 & higher):

Medals shall be awarded to the top three placements in each category. In a category where there are less than three entries, then the number of medals awarded shall equal the number of entries. Medal presentation times will be scheduled and posted in the Arena. **Skaters are asked to wear competition outfits and skates.**

MEDAL/CERTIFICATE PRESENTATIONS (STAR 1-3):

Presentation times will take place following the completion of each group.

MUSIC:

All music must be submitted electronically with online registration. Any music files not submitted with online registration will result in the skater being withdrawn from the Event. Please ensure correct music files are uploaded. Music file changes and mislabeled music files will be charged a \$25 administrative fee. Skaters/Coaches should have a **USB** copy of music available at ice level, during the Event. CD's, phones, or other personal devices will **NOT** be accepted.

MUSIC UPLOAD INFORMATION:

- Music must be submitted for **all** categories/segments (ie: short program, free program etc.).
- Music files **must** be MP3.
- Music uploads **must** be named in the following format: **First Name Last Name - Category Program Type**
- First and Last Name **must** match the athlete's name as written on their Uplifter profile.

Category Program Type includes:

- **Category** (ie: STAR 5)
- **Discipline** (ie: Women/Girls, Men/Boys)
- **Segment** (ie: Short Program or Free Program, if applicable)
- **Age category** (ie: U10, if applicable)

Examples:

John Smith - STAR 5 Men 13&Over
Suzie Smith - PreNovice Women Short Program

COACH ACCREDITATION:

Coaches must be a minimum of NCCP Regional Coach In-Training and be a current Professional Coaching Member of Skate Canada, in Good Standing.
