ONLINE REGISTRATION:

Registration for all categories will take place on the Skate Canada Newfoundland and Labrador

Methods of payment include: VISA, MasterCard and Discover Card. PrePaid VISA/MasterCard gift cards are also accepted.

Registration Opens: Monday, November 29, 2021 at 10:00AM

Registration Deadline: Wednesday, December 8, 2021

Late entries will NOT be accepted.

REFUND POLICY:

Refund requests must be made by **Wednesday, December 8, 2021**. After this date, all refunds will require a medical note and are subject to a \$25 administration fee. Medical notes must be submitted within **14 days** of the Event.

AGE RESTRICTIONS:

Age is considered to be the age of the skater before July 1, preceding the Event.

ELIGIBILITY:

Skaters who participated in a qualifying category (PreNovice and higher) at the SCNL Sectional Championships, in the current year, are ineligible for a STARSkate category, in the same discipline, at Divisionals and Provincials.

TEST/ASSESSMENT QUALIFYING DEADLINE:

Test/Assessment requirements must be met at the time of online registration.

MUSIC:

All music must be submitted electronically with online registration. Music files must be .mp3 and labeled as "Skaters Name_ Category_Age Category". Skaters should also have a CD copy of music available at ice level, during the Event.

COACHES ACCREDITATION:

Coaches must be a minimum of NCCP Regional Coach In-Training and be a current Professional Coaching Member of Skate Canada, in Good Standing.

SCHEDULE:

A schedule will be posted on the SCNL website ([SCNL Divisional Qualifying Events \(Eastern, Western & Labrador\) – Skate Canada – Newfoundland & Labrador \(skatenl.com\)](http://www.skatenl.com)) as soon as possible after the deadline for registration.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION:

All skaters and spectators must sign-in at the registration table when arriving at the Event.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

More information on COVID-19 regulations will be communicated to participants prior to the Event.

AWARDS:

The top three placements in each category will be awarded a prize. In a category where there are less than three entries, the number of prizes will equal the number of entries.

MEDAL PRESENTATIONS:

Medals presentations will take place immediately following the official results of each category. **Skaters are asked to wear competition outfits and skates.**

PROVINCIALS QUALIFYING CATEGORIES:

- Girls/Women – Labrador Divisionals (Top three placements)
- Girls/Women – Eastern & Western Divisionals (Top eight placements)

In the event that any of the qualifying placements do not enter the Provincial Championships, the next placed skater in the category shall be considered eligible and will be notified.

Skaters qualifying to go to the Skate Canada Newfoundland and Labrador Provincial Championships must register online, immediately following the completion of their Divisional Event, and no later than **Wednesday, January 26, 2022.**

Skaters who participate in a qualifying category at Divisionals are ineligible to enter a byed category, in the same discipline, at the Provincial Championships.

BYED CATEGORIES:

All STAR 8, 9, 10 and Gold FreeSkate; CompetitiveSkate; Special Olympics, ADULTSkate, Boys/Men, Pairs and Dance competitors shall receive a bye through the Divisional Championships. Registration for the SCNL Provincials Championships must be completed online (<https://skatenf.uplifterinc.com>) no later than **January 26, 2022**.

Byes may also be granted in single entry categories at Divisionals. SCNL will inform skaters if they are eligible for a bye not later than 7 days after the registration deadline. Skaters then have 7 days, from the date of notice, to accept a bye and withdraw without penalty. Additional byes may be granted in extenuating circumstances and must be made in writing with supporting documents to the Executive Committee of Skate Canada Newfoundland and Labrador.

The Skate Canada Newfoundland and Labrador Provincial Championships is a qualifying Event for the Atlantic Canada Skating Championships.

ACCIDENTS / LIABILITY:

Skate Canada, Skate Canada NL and the Local Volunteer Team undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by skaters.
