Entry fees include: Event registration, a digital action photo, and an \$8 Officials & Technology Fee, per skater. All categories are subject to the availability of qualified officials. Categories may be divided into groups by age, if necessary.

ONLINE REGISTRATION:

Registration for all categories will take place online at the Skate Canada Newfoundland and Labrador registration website: https://skatenf.uplifterinc.com.

Methods of payment include: VISA, MasterCard and Discover Card. Pre-paid VISA/MasterCard gift cards are also accepted.

Registration Opens: Monday, February 21, 2022, at 10:00AM **Registration Deadline:** Wednesday, March 2, 2022, at 11:59PM

Late entries will not be accepted.

REFUND POLICY:

Refund requests must be made by **Wednesday, March 2, 2022**. After this date, all refunds will require a medical note and are subject to a \$25 administration fee. Medical notes must be submitted within **14 days** of the Event. If the Event is cancelled due to COVID-19, refunds will be processed less a 10% administration fee.

ASSESSMENT QUALIFICATIONS:

Assessment requirements must be met at the time of online registration.

AGE RESTRICTIONS:

Age is the age of the skater before July 1, preceding the event.



MUSIC:

If applicable, music must be submitted electronically with online registration. Music files must be .mp3 and labeled as "Skaters Name_Category_Age Category". Skaters should also have a CD copy of music available at ice level, during the Event.

COACHES ACCREDITATION:

Coaches must be a minimum of NCCP Regional Coach In-Training and be a current Professional Coaching Member of Skate Canada, in Good Standing.

SCHEDULE:

A detailed schedule will be posted on the SCNL website (<u>Event Calendar – Skate Canada – Newfoundland & Labrador (skatenl.com)</u>) as soon as possible after the deadline for registration.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION:

All skaters and spectators must sign-in at on-site registration when arriving at the Event.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

More information on COVID-19 regulations will be communicated to participants prior to the Event.

CERTIFICATE PRESENTATIONS:

All skaters in **Skate to Standard** categories will receive an evaluation certificate & report card, to be presented following the completion of the category.
